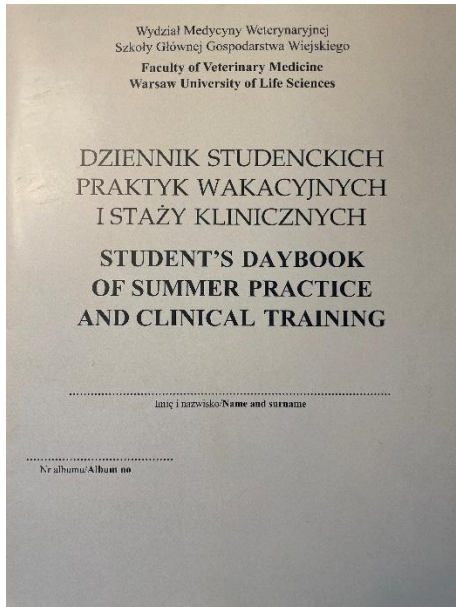


Student's Daybook of Summer Practice and Clinical Training

- activities performed under supervision
- stamp and signature of the academic teacher => supervisor
- final credit is needed in the student's daybook**
- The supervisor may require additional materials such as case studies.

Day One Skills

- Two out of the four skills must be confirmed, excluding patomorphological examination.
- For patomorphological examination, **four confirmations** are required, covering a minimum of **two animal species**.
- Two necropsy reports must be completed. A necropsy report is not equivalent to patomorphological examination.

Who can sign the skill confirmation?

- academic teacher during academic year
- supervisor during the summer practice (as stated in the practice referral)
- supervisor during non-mandatory practice (as stated in the authorisation available in the Dean's office)
